

Model for Providing Incentives for Teaching Up-to-Date Knowledge

Abstract: Providing up-to-date educational content to learners remains one of the challenges for educational institutions. Existing literature has not yet found a general consensus on designing the structure and processes of knowledge sharing within an educational institution. The current study aims at filling this gap by suggesting a model that includes an incentive mechanism for motivating teachers to exchange educational contents. Analyses results show that a proper incentive mechanism increases the cooperation between teachers on knowledge sharing within educational institutions. Finally, it has to be emphasized that finding an optimum solution is constraint to teachers' behaviors.
